

At IIT Bombay we are actively engaged in ensuring that we practice Green technologies as we develop and grow. The Institute is assisted in these endeavours through a "Green Campus Committee". This committee is comprised of members drawn from various institute departments. The current committee is comprised of Dean IPS as the Chairman, Prof.M.B.Patil EE as the Convener, Prof.Chetan Solanki DESE, Prof.Milind Rane ME, Prof.Suparna Mukherjee CESE, Prof.Jothi Prakash CE, Executive Engr. (Electrical), Physical Health Officer and a student representative. The committee covers people with passionate interest in the well being of campus flora and fauna, energy, environment and water resources. The Institute is also covering part of its energy consumption through a 1MW grid connected solar PV panels mounted on various academic building terraces and is committed to GRIHA 3/4 norms in all its new constructions.

The Institute has through its academia offered several solutions for major societal problems through research efforts viz establishment of a climate centre, cleaning up of national lakes and water bodies (e.g. consortium for the Ganga clean up) and other outreach programmes. There are mandatory environmental courses for the undergraduate students and the depts., of Energy Science and Environmental Science are being promoted in a big way.
