This scholarship enables students to pay fees equivalent to those of Indian postgraduate students. ● IIT Gandhinagar provides financial assistance to international students through fellowships, easing their academic journey and covering additional expenses. ● IITGN has developed a coursework track for its master's program to facilitate seamless exchange of students from foreign countries.

IITGN established a dedicated team towards forging new partnerships with the corporations, foundations, philanthropic organizations, and international institutions that have an interest in supporting research aligned with their goals. This is done through signing of MoUs, MoAs etc for joint working and co-operation.2. We are constantly and actively promoting our research capabilities and successes to attract the attention of potential industries by conducting Industry open houses, conferences, seminars and leveraging the social media and traditional media channels. Recently, IITGN conducted CoLab2024 which gave opportunity to our faculty to interact with various industry people.3. Further, IITGN has established Research Park to support industry –academia engagement and around 20 companies are working in it in addition to the start-ups.4. IITGN has dedicated incubation center equipped with office space, mentorship programs, networking opportunities, and access to funding resources which provides a supportive environment for budding entrepreneurs to develop their ideas into viable businesses. As a result, we have supported over 75 startups in the last 5 years. In addition, a number of alumni have also started startup companies after spending a few years in the Industry.5. We have a dedicated team which regularly monitors the performance and progress of startups incubated within the ecosystem.6. IITGN has an advisory committee for Research Park and Incubation Centre that conducts regular meetings and engages with Industry leaders and takes advices and moves the agenda forward.
