In response to your email dated 1 January 2018 regarding subject cited matter. The point-wise reply from IIT Jodhpur is as under:

(a) Whether only 66 percent of IITians have got job opportunities during 2016-17 as compared to 79 percent in 2015-16 and 78 percent in 2014-15.

Answer: 50% of students got job opportunities during 2016-17 whereas 73% students got placed in 2015-16 and 72% in 2014-15, which are showing comparatively declining percentage of placement.

(b) Whether the above reflects stagnation or economic downturn;

Answer: The above decrease in the job opportunities might be due to economic downturn and other vested factors.

(C) to what extent the protectionist steps taken by US, UK, Australia, New Zealand, Saudi Arabia and other countries impacted prospects of Indian IITians and others; and

Answer: In IIT Jodhpur, the students are placed within India only, so the protectionist steps shall not any effect on the same




