(a) Whether the Government agrees with the view that massive changes in the scientific and technological fields such as artificial intelligence, data analytics and learning by machine, robotics etc. will not only wipe out unskilled manpower involving mathematics, computer science and data science coupled with multidisciplinary abilities across physical science, social science and humanities;

**Reply:** To face such challenges, IIT Indore has geared up and offering some programs and planning to offer more programs. Few of them are listed below:

1. **Master of Science in Data Science and Management:** It is a two years comprehensive program that focuses both on business knowledge and technical expertise. It is being, jointly offered online by IIT Indore and IIM Indore to provide comprehensive knowledge to future data scientists. It was started in the Academic Year (AY) 2021-22 with 42 students and with the admission of AY 2022-23 the total student strength of program is 84.
2. **B.Tech. Mathematics and Computing:** IIT Indore going to start a new UG program from the AY 2023-24. This program will cover Mathematics as well as Computer Science and students will spend time in laboratory. This program will focus on Pure Mathematics, Applied Mathematics, Probability and Statistics, Financial & Industrial Mathematics, and Data Science. Also an wide range of advanced level elective courses will be offered to the students to choose the courses as per their choice and interest.

3. **M.Tech. in Applied Optics and Laser Technology:** IIT Indore & Raja Ramanna Centre for Advanced Technology (RRCAT) will be offering this course jointly from AY 2023-24. As per the key objective of the program it will train Scientists and Engineers to meet the growing demand for skilled professionals in the field of Applied optics and LASER Technology. Apply the knowledge acquired in science and technology of Lasers in academia and industry. Design experiments and assemble standard optical tools for optical experimentation and develop novel products and solutions for advanced optical systems. This program will focus on the Applied optics, LASER Technology, Applications of Optics and Laser in different field, Manufacturing, Material Processing, Electronics and telecommunication, Sensors and Transducers, Astronomical systems, Biomedical systems.
4. **M.Tech. in Electric Vehicle Technology:** Keeping in view the mandate by NITI Aayog and great push by Govt. of India and to accelerate Innovation, Research, Development, Incubation and to start PG program Electric Vehicles so to create skilled manpower required by the Country in near future and to develop a sustainable ecosystem for entrepreneurship in the field of EV, IIT Indore established the Center for Electric Vehicles and Intelligent Transport Systems (CEVITS) and started MTech and MTech + PhD dual degree program in Electric Vehicles from AY 2021-22.
5. **Multidisciplinary Web-Based Academic Programs for Industry:** For skill improvement of existing work force of the industry, IIT Indore has planned Web-based Academic programs. This program will be Industry specific. Such programs can be offered in Online Mode, Offline Mode as well as in Hybrid Mode.
6. In addition to the above programs, as per the approval of the Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India, IIT Indore has established the "Jai Prakash Narayan National Centre for Excellence in the Humanities". This centre will take care of academics, research and outreach activities in the field of humanities.






